Founded more than one century ago, we know at Rockland Trust that to succeed as a company the communities where we live and work must thrive. As a community-focused bank, we are committed to using our resources to strengthen local economies and help small businesses, individuals, and families succeed.

We support the growth and well-being of our communities through charitable giving programs, community initiatives, and employee volunteerism. In 2016, Rockland Trust and its affiliated foundations donated more than \$1.07 million in aggregate grants to education, health and human services, youth, affordable housing, and community development programs. In addition, we provided scholarships through our annual scholarship competition to Massachusetts college-bound high school seniors and schoolchildren enrolled in Reading Makes Cent\$ — our summer reading and financial savings program.

Rockland Trust also supports our local communities through our people. We’ve always been a Company where our colleagues get actively involved. In 2016, employees rolled up their sleeves and volunteered a total of 3,623 hours of their time to community organizations through RockCorp, our Company’s community outreach program.

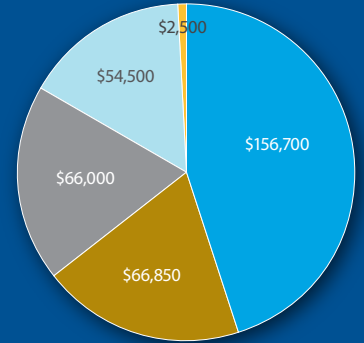
Charitable Giving Summary

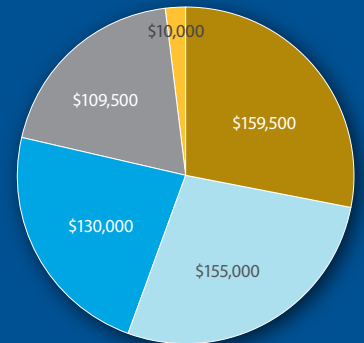

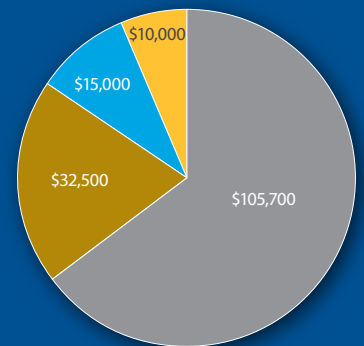
