Reading Makes Cent\$

This year will mark the 15th year of Rockland Trust's Reading Makes Cent\$ program. The program is for students entering grades 1 through 8 in the fall. Students can earn \$2.50 in a Rockland Trust savings account for each book they read, up to 10 books. The program runs from June 1 through August 31. Accounts may be opened/credited until September 15. Summer reading journals are available in all branches and on **www.RocklandTrust.com/read** starting June 1.

We've had over 192,000 books read and have paid out more than \$480,000 to students!

For every book that the student reads between June 1, 2023 and August 31, 2023 he/she will receive a \$2.50 deposit into a Rockland Trust Savings Makes Cent\$ account, up to 10 books or \$25. The student must read at least 4 books to qualify for the initial \$10 account opening deposit. Once the student reads 4 books and makes the corresponding journal entries during the 2023 program timeframe, Rockland Trust will open a Savings Makes Cent\$ account in the child's name. After the initial 4 book threshold, students may bring in their completed journal and request a deposit in any increment up to the \$25 limit. Accounts may be opened and/or credited until September 15, 2023. To open the account and qualify for the \$10 reward deposit, the student must go to a local Rockland Trust branch accompanied by their parent or legal guardian and complete a Reading Makes Cent\$ enrollment form and all necessary account opening paperwork. The parent or guardian will need to be a co-owner of the student's savings account. Program, rules and eligibility subject to change at any time.

To log in to mobile banking, use the same User ID and Password that you use to log in to your online banking account.

Download the Rockland Trust Mobile Banking app by visiting the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.

Mobile Deposit

Mobile deposit offers you the speed and ease of depositing checks without visiting a branch location.

After snapping a picture of the front and back of your check and submitting it for processing, you will have funds available the next business day for approved deposits made before 7:00 p.m. ET. Deposits requiring additional review may be due to deposits over daily limit, poor images or missing information. **See your account agreement for details.**

Ground Beef & Pasta Skillet



Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 pound 90% lean ground beef
- 8 ounces mushrooms, finely chopped or pulsed in a food processor
- ½ cup diced onion
- 1 15-ounce can no-salt-added tomato sauce
- 1 cup water
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon garlic powder
- 8 ounces whole-wheat rotini or fusilli
- ½ cup shredded extra-sharp Cheddar cheese
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh basil for garnish


Instructions

Heat oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add beef, mushrooms and onion and cook, stirring, until the beef is no longer pink and the mushroom liquid is mostly evaporated, 8 to 10 minutes. Stir in tomato sauce, water, Worcestershire, Italian seasoning, salt and garlic powder. Add pasta. Bring to a boil. Cover, reduce heat and cook, stirring once or twice, until the pasta is tender and most of the liquid is absorbed, 16-18 minutes. Sprinkle the pasta with cheese, cover and cook until the cheese is melted, 2 to 3 minutes more. Garnish with basil, if desired.
