Here is What to Expect & When

Week of April 24	 Rockland Trust Debit Cards and PINs will be mailed. Online Banking package will be mailed to existing Online Banking customers. To ensure a smooth transition, we recommend that you contact Edgartown National Bank to verify that your email address and phone number are correct prior to May 10th.
Week of May 8	 For your records, it's recommended that you download or print copies of your electronic statements and transaction history, including bill payment history.
Friday, May 12	 All of the Edgartown National Bank branches will be open normal business hours. As of 4:00 p.m., Edgartown National Bank Online Banking, Bill Pay, and Telephone Banking will be unavailable. Starting on Monday, May 15th you can begin using Rockland Trust Online and Mobile Banking, Bill Pay, and Telephone Banking. A final Edgartown National Bank account statement for all checking and savings accounts will be mailed to you with up-to-date information as of May 12th.
Saturday – Sunday May 13 – 14	 All Edgartown National Bank branches will be closed. Use your Edgartown National Bank Debit Card for withdrawals and purchases through Sunday, May 14th — after this date, your card will be deactivated and should be destroyed.
Monday, May 15	 All branches will open as Rockland Trust at normal business hours. Activate your Rockland Trust Debit Card. Contact service providers that process any automatic payments from your debit card and provide them your new Rockland Trust Debit Card number. Get started with Rockland Trust Online Banking at RocklandTrust.com. Register for Telephone Banking. Download our Mobile Banking app. You're invited to join our online customer community.
