Many of our colleagues participated in a blood drive in Worcester for Boston Children's Hospital on September 16, 2020.



## Soup's On: Italian Wedding Soup



### What You'll Need

#### **Meatballs**

1 tablespoon olive oil

½ lb. ground beef 80% lean

½ lb. ground pork

1 lightly beaten egg

½ cup Italian breadcrumbs

1/4 cup Parmesan cheese (grated into powder)

3 cloves minced garlic

½ cup roughly chopped fresh parsley

Salt and pepper to taste

#### Soup

1 ¼ cups diced carrots

1 1/4 cups diced yellow onion

34 cup diced celery

1 tablespoon minced garlic

8 cups chicken broth

2 teaspoons Italian seasoning

Salt and pepper to taste

34 cup dry acini de pepe pasta

8 oz. fresh spinach

### **Instructions**

Pour the olive oil in a large skillet. Gently combine the remaining meatball ingredients and roll the mixture into 1-inch balls. Brown the meatballs on the stovetop for 2-3 minutes. The inside of the meatballs will finish cooking in the soup.

Add the carrots, onion, celery, garlic, chicken broth, Italian seasoning, and browned meatballs into a slow cooker. Cook on high for 4 hours or low for 8 hours. When your soup has finished cooking, add the acini de pepe and cook on low for 30 more minutes. Stir in the spinach when time is up. Garnish with any leftover Parmesan cheese and parsley.
