Here is What to Expect and When

Late October	 An online banking package will be mailed to existing online banking customers. You will need to verify that your email address and phone number are up to date within East Boston Savings Bank Online Banking prior to November 8th.
Week of November 1	Rockland Trust Debit Cards and PINs will be sent in separate mailings.
Week of November 8	 For your records, it's recommended that you download or print copies of your eStatements and online banking transaction history. Passbook Savings account holders should visit their local branch and have their passbook updated prior to November 12th. After 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 10th, access to East Boston Savings Bank Bill Pay will be unavailable.
Friday, November 12	 The following East Boston Savings Bank branches will be closed all day: 1 Bennington St., East Boston 126 Squire Rd., Revere 317 Main St., Saugus 430 West Broadway, South Boston 501 Southampton St., South Boston 1441 Beacon St., Brookline 2250 Dorchester Ave., Dorchester 489 Gallivan Blvd., Dorchester All other East Boston Savings Bank branches will close at 4:00 p.m. Mobile Check Deposit will be unavailable as of 4:00 p.m. In addition, East Boston Savings Bank Online and Mobile Banking, and Telephone Banking will be unavailable as of 5:00 p.m. Starting on Monday, November 15th, you can begin using Rockland Trust Online and Mobile Banking, Bill Pay, and Telephone Banking. A final East Boston Savings Bank account statement for all checking and savings accounts will be mailed to you with up-to-date information as of November 12th.
Saturday – Sunday November 13 – 14	 All East Boston Savings Bank branches will remain closed. Use your East Boston Savings Bank ATM/Visa Debit Card for withdrawals and purchases through Sunday, November 14th. After this date, your card will be deactivated and should be destroyed.
Monday, November 15	 You can now use any Rockland Trust branch. Activate your new Rockland Trust Debit Card. Contact service providers that process any automatic payments from your debit card and provide them with your new Rockland Trust Debit Card number. Access your account(s) online at RocklandTrust.com. Download the Rockland Trust Mobile Banking app. Register for Rockland Trust Telephone Banking by calling 508.732.7072 or visit your local branch.

Call-to-Action Items

Prior to November 8, 2021

□ Verify that your email address and phone number are up to date within East Boston Savings Bank Online Banking.

Prior to November 15, 2021

- Download or print copies of your eStatements and online banking transaction history.
- □ Visit your local branch and have your Passbook Savings account(s) updated.

On or after November 15, 2021

- □ Activate your new Rockland Trust Debit Card.
- □ Start using Rockland Trust Online Banking and Bill Pay.
- □ Download the Rockland Trust Mobile Banking app.
- Order new Rockland Trust checks. You will receive a communication in late November on how to order your new Rockland Trust checks.
- Register for Rockland Trust Telephone Banking and establish an access number and telephone PIN by calling 508.732.7072 or visit your local branch.
- Contact service providers that process any automatic payments from your debit card and provide them with your new Rockland Trust Debit Card number.
- Contact businesses/individuals that send wires to your account and provide them the Rockland Trust routing and transit number (011304478).
